Bergevin Lane Vineyards 2016 Princess Syrah, 95 pts.

Exquisitely crafted with harmonic layers of blackberry, violet, red plum, cassis, anise, forest floor and tea leaf. A second layered wave reveals earthen underpinnings of leather, pencil shavings and dark espresso accents that linger on the long well-structured finish. Sourced from Francisca's Vineyard in the Walla Walla Valley. \$50

Bergevin Lane Vineyards 2016 Moonspell Cabernet Sauvignon 92 pts.

The supple texture of this Cabernet is backlit with fresh acidity, boasting polished flavors of blackberry, raspberry, currants and vanilla. Well-integrated tannins converge on the vibrant finish with hints of graphite, baking spice and dried thyme. \$35

Bergevin Lane Vineyards 2018 Love-Struck Viognier 90 pts.

This silky white flows effortlessly, delivering engaging florality to the aromas and flavor profile. Honeysuckle, mandarin orange, white stone fruit, river rock and a touch of spice are backed with another round of fresh flower blossoms on the finish. \$20
